Shinning Stars Program

Report of the Superintendent - Mr. Seddon recognized the efforts of National Junior Honor Society students from C.W. Lewis Middle School who had participated in a cancer awareness project.

The Superintendent commented on the results of the annual Violence & Vandalism Report from the 2007-2008 school year. In addition Mr. Seddon listed the various devoted activities which would occur during Violence and Vandalism Week. Included in those activities, aimed at reducing violent acts, were: public service announcements on anti-bullying, peer mediation activities, assemblies, increased access to guidance counselors, self-esteem, random acts of kindness, dating violence, and DARE activities.

The Superintendent inquired if there were any questions from the Board or members of the audience. (there were no questions)

Mr. Seddon stated that he had met with the Chief of Police regarding school safety issues and that additional meetings with the Police Department and Administration would be held. The Superintendent indicated that the information from the reported Violence and Vandalism Report can be reviewed on the district's website.

The Superintendent also spoke on the topic of school consolidation. Specifically the State of New Jersey - Department of Education is in the initial stages of a state mandated school consolidation review process. To date certain meetings (exploratory) have been held between officials of neighboring school districts. To proceed any further however it is recommended that a feasibility study be conducted.
